ACTIVITY CHOICES - All activities will be presented at age appropriate levels. All classes are subject to change.

MINIMUM # of Students: 10 per class **MAXIMUM # of Students:** 20 per class

EVERYDAY:

SNACK - A healthy snack and drink will be provided. Parents are responsible for providing any food allergy information on registration forms. Snacks may be brought in by the student but no high sugar items or candy will be allowed.

HOMEWORK - The scheduled homework time is a "quiet zone" time where students will have a tutor available. Students and parents will sign a contract agreeing to the terms of the "quiet zone." If and when homework is completed, students are permitted to study, read silently or practice handwriting (drawing for PreK).

STRUCTURED PLAY - Students will participate in active physical activity that will be guided / supervised by teachers. Play will take place outside on the playground, weather permitting.

MONDAY:

HISTORY - Students will learn about important moments in History through an interactive lesson and activities that will include "Twilight Zone" reenactments.

MATH - Math is fun! Students will use a variety of age appropriate games and hands-on activities to help students improve their understanding and skills of this subject. Students will see how math skills are used in everyday living.

TUESDAY:

ARTS & CRAFTS - Students will learn many techniques to turn ideas into their own creative reality. Self-expression is the goal - not perfect pleasing art!

DANCE - Students will get their energy out before going home for the night. Simple dance moves to appropriate music will be taught or if free-style is the desire, we will dance on!

WEDNESDAY:

BUSINESS BUILDERS - Students really make great entrepreneurs - they have great ideas and no fears. Students will be taught to turn their ideas into value for others, set goals, develop plans and how to work towards their goals.

STORYTELLING / ACTING - No devices needed - only an imagination. Students will discover if they love creating, acting or both through student and instructor guided prompts. This will be a fun practice and who knows - we might have the next Steven Spielberg or Meryl Streep right here at SMMCS.

THURSDAY:

BOOK READ ALONG - Great readers often become great thinkers. By reading both silently and out loud, students will improve their ability to understand the written word and discover through guided discussions what the author wants his audience to know.
